Grammar and Usage Rubric - Indiana

Rubric includes: capitalization, punctuation, word wall words, and plurals. Students are required to write a minimum of 3 sentences about school. Use the rubric on the bottom of the page to score students writing.

Grading Rubric for Writing Assignment

ESL / EFL teachers should expect errors in each area and make appropriate concessions in their scoring. Rubrics should be based on a keen understanding of English learner communicative levels. This essay writing rubric provides a scoring system which is more appropriate to English learners than standard rubrics.

Holistic rubrics describe the work by applying all the criteria at the same time and enabling an overall judgment about the quality of the work. The top panel of Figure 1.2 defines analytic and holistic rubrics and lists advantages and disadvantages for each. For most classroom purposes, analytic rubrics are best.
